How to Check for/Install an Insert on a Single Leg Board

Tools Needed



1/4" Socket
or Nut Driver



These instructions are intended to be used to both check for an existing insert on a board with a single leg AND install a new insert. The instructions are written assuming you are checking for insert, however.

Step One Remove female leg

With board in upright position, remove the four screws found on the top leg plate.

Separate the top leg (female) from the bottom leg connected to cabinet (male). The old insert should fall out upon removal of leg. Make sure insert is removed before proceeding to next step.



Step Two Check for insert



When removing separating the female leg from the male leg, a small rod should fall out of the female leg, resembling one of the inserts shown. If no insert falls out, try tapping the female leg lightly on a hard surface. If no insert falls out, you are likely missing an insert.

Please call us at 1-800-536-9495 to order a new insert and return to this instructions as a reference for installation. If you have already ordered an insert, proceed with instructions.

Step Two Install new insert

Place new insert into the female leg.



Step Three Re-install female leg

Re-connect female and male leg, and re-tighten screws on the female leg plate. Lower the board and ensure the board now lays flat. If not, please call us for troubleshooting.
